How to read the Louth Academy Timetable

This is the period of the day you will have the lesson. There are 6 periods per day

This is the room where you will have your lesson

These are the initials of the teacher who will be taking the lesson. These initials are at the bottom of your timetable with the name of the teacher next to them.

This is the class/group you are in

Your class/group. What does this mean?

You read your class/group in the following way: 7m/Cm1

- **7** is the year group you are in
- **m** is the band you are in
- **Cm** is the subject, in this case Chemistry
- **1** is the group you are in

How do I know where my lesson is?

In the example above the lesson is in **10F**. this means

- **1** is the teaching block the lesson is in (there are 3 in total)
- **0** is the floor it is on (0 – ground floor, 1 first floor - upstairs)
- **A** is the room on that floor

In the example above if your timetable said you were in 10F. You would have a lesson in **Block 1** on the **ground floor** in **room F**
